OUR VISION FOR THE FUTURE

1. Credible and defensible, fact-based policies and decision-making.

1. Decisions affecting the rights and economy of British Columbians will be based on solid, credible and defensible fact-based decision making.

2. Lower Taxation for our citizens.

1. Reduced Property Tax.
2. Elimination of Carbon Tax.
3. Decrease PST.
4. No taxation on the first \$250,000 for businesses.
5. Greatly reduced personal income taxes for our working and middle class.



3. Improving our Justice System.

- 1. Implementation of simple, easy to understand laws.**
- 2. Harsher sentencing for serious crimes.**
- 3. Making Judges both elected and accountable to the public they serve.**
- 4. Those guilty and incarcerated will perform civic duty and their labour used on projects to benefit society (Introduction of civic duty and labour programs for inmates)**
- 5. People convicted of serious crimes (rape, murder, etc) lose their constitutional rights for life or until pardoned.**
- 6. Addiction to be treated as a public health issue and not a criminal matter, relieving the court system of unnecessary caseload and backlog.**

4. Improving our security and promoting independence from Ottawa.

- 1. Replace the RCMP with a BCP answerable to the Office of the Premier**
- 2. Establish BC Coastal Defence Force to protect our resources and coastline.**
- 3. Take over border security with a BC-Border Patrol**
- 4. We will develop a CSIS equivalent intelligence service**
- 5. UN influence and mandates will be eliminated within an independant British Columbia.**



5. Building a real partnership with our First Nations.

- 1. Our party will work to achieve a real middle ground for all British Columbians including our First Nations as part of the process.**
- 2. We will develop a real working relationship with First Nations Councils and Leadership including the creation of a government system that directly involves our First Nations Communities and their leadership.**
- 3. Better provisions for First Nations to participate in, and benefit from sustainable resource development as partners.**

6. Fixing our Social Assistance programs to get money to those who need it most.

- 1. Elimination of all social assistance programs to non-British Columbian Citizens.**
- 2. Close monitoring of social benefits programs to recipients - ensure need, eliminate abuse.**
- 3. Providing a fair living wage to our elderly who have laboured for a lifetime and are now retired and in poverty.**
- 4. Retraining programs for needed professions for those who are under or unemployed.**
- 5. Workfare and training programs for all able-bodied chronically unemployed people.**
- 6. Greatly improved support for veterans with a focus on healing and re-integrating into society**



7. Improving Education for all British Columbians.

- 1. A greater focus on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics language, and trades programs in our schools.**
- 2. Elimination of all political ideologies from our classrooms with a greater focus on teaching research skills and critical thinking.**
- 3. Changing our school system to encourage a safe and positive learning environment for both students and teachers.**
- 4. Improving and Modernizing Distance Education Programs from Gr 1 - 12.**
- 5. Improved retraining programs to ensure continued employment within the structure of the provincial or private sector from professions which are declining within the province.**

8. Enshrining the rights of the British Columbian working middle class.

- 1. Stronger rights protection for working people in British Columbia..**
- 2. Review existing legislation regarding safety equipment and training.**
- 3. Better compensation for dangerous working environments**
- 4. Overhauling the Translink Corporation to provide better service, at lower rates.**
- 5. Re-establish affordable public transportation between communities throughout the province, not just in the major cities.**
- 6. Opening the ability for class action lawsuits on illegal protests that inhibit/restrict legitimate economic activity.**



9. Real Property Rights for British Columbians.

- 1. Improving the property rights for British Columbians to ensure they are fairly compensated for annexed land.**
- 2. The legal right to defend one's person, family, and/or property.**
- 3. We will ensure municipal governments are more accountable for how our tax money is spent.**
- 4. Elimination of property taxes for low-income senior citizens.**

10. Better management of our natural resources.

- 1. Updating and changing government policies to make our forestry industry competitive once again.**
- 2. Better strategic management of our fisheries and oceans including seal and sea lion controls.**
- 3. Policies will be created to encourage more finished products from our raw materials here in BC thus creating jobs and wealth for our people.**
- 4. Eliminate impediments to resource development, including, but not limited to: illegal protests and government bureaucracy.**
- 5. Foreign-funded interference in our resource sector will be eliminated with punishments including, but not limited to fines, penalties and jail time.**



11. Forcing politicians to be accountable to their constituents.

- 1. Wasteful, unnecessary government spending will be eliminated.**
- 2. Term limits will be instituted to prevent “career politicians”.**
- 3. Our party will institute real, and harsh punishments for violations of public trust such as corruption, conflict of interest, such as fines and criminal sentencing.**
- 4. People in positions of power will be made to be accountable for their actions and decisions**
- 5. We will ensure that Politicians, at any level, will no longer be able to grant themselves raises.**
- 6. We will implement base salaries + performance bonuses based on factors such as economic growth and the overall standard of living of British Columbians.**
- 7. Government pensions for politicians will start at 60 years of age.**
- 8. We will create a position for an independent Ombudsman who is to be elected with the sole mandate to oversee government officials, critically evaluate their performance, and their commitment to election promises.**
- 9. We will decrease both size and scope at all levels of government through a new constitution which guarantees increased rights to British Columbians.**
- 10. Lobbyists, Special Interest Groups and NGOs will be prohibited from pressuring our legislature and its elected representatives.**



12. Firearm Legislation

- 1. The position of Chief Firearms Officer for British Columbia will be staffed by a firearms expert, with a mandate to protect the property rights of the legal and legitimate firearms owners of British Columbia.**
- 2. Direct action will be taken to make British Columbia a sanctuary area for legal firearms ownership and shooting sports.**
- 3. The right to own firearms with approved training and certification, will become a constitutionally protected right.**

13. Vehicle Insurance

- 1. Develop legislation which encourages driving history based insurance programs for British Columbians.**
- 2. Open up the market to privatized insurance companies with strict guidelines on compensation and coverage to protect the consumer.**

14. Charitable Organizations and Nonprofits.

- 1. Reviewing the eligibility of charitable, non-profit organizations will be critically evaluated to ensure the money is going to those who need it most.**
- 2. Mandatory annual audits of funds exiting the country to ensure that money raised goes to ethical causes and the people who need it, and not warlords or fronts for terrorism.**



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
